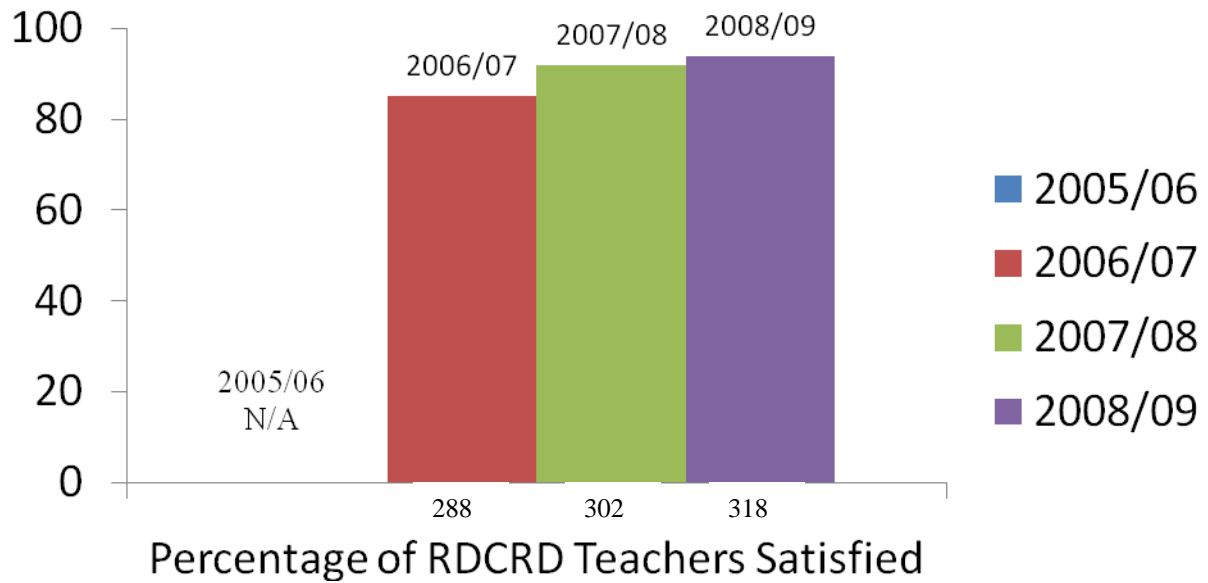

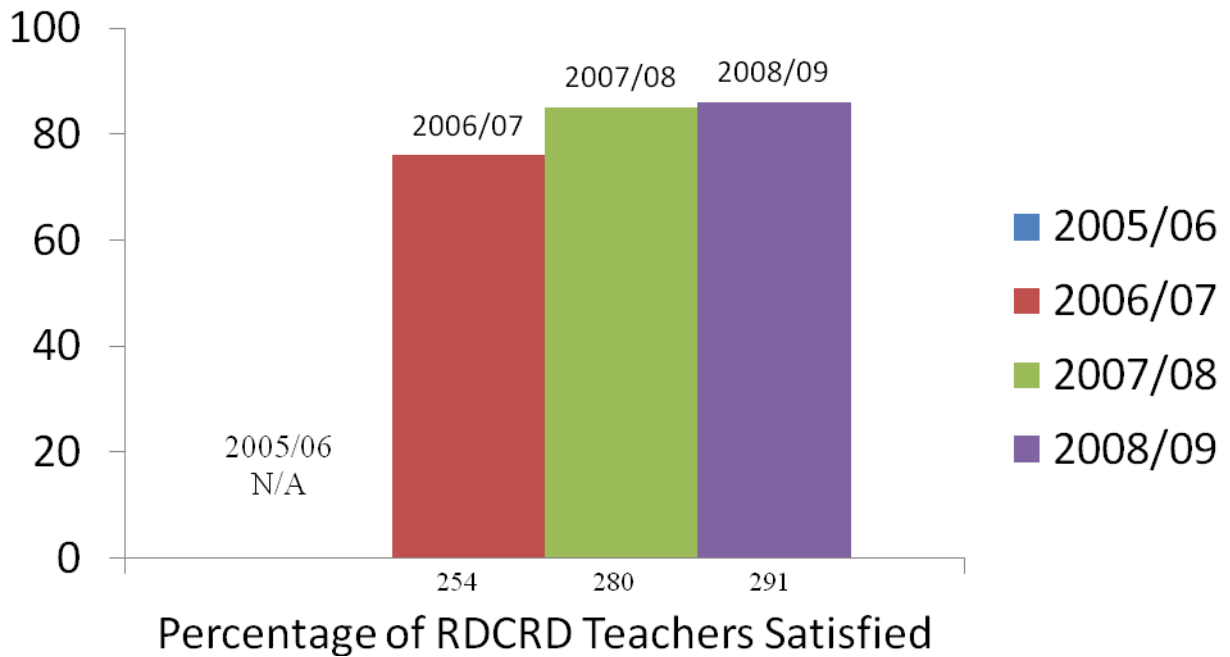

Schollie Survey Results Comparison

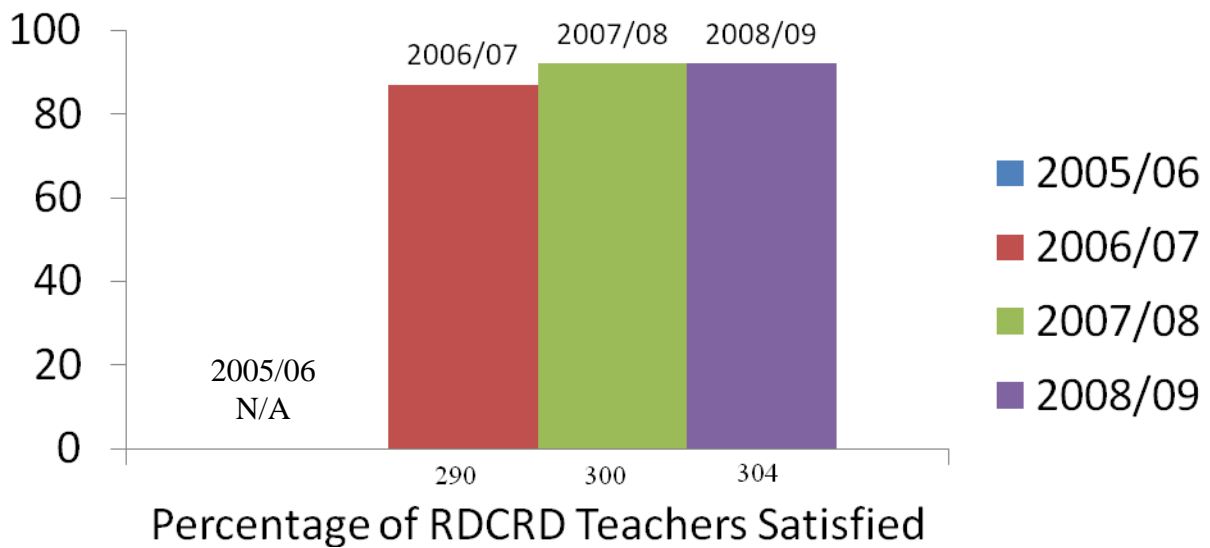

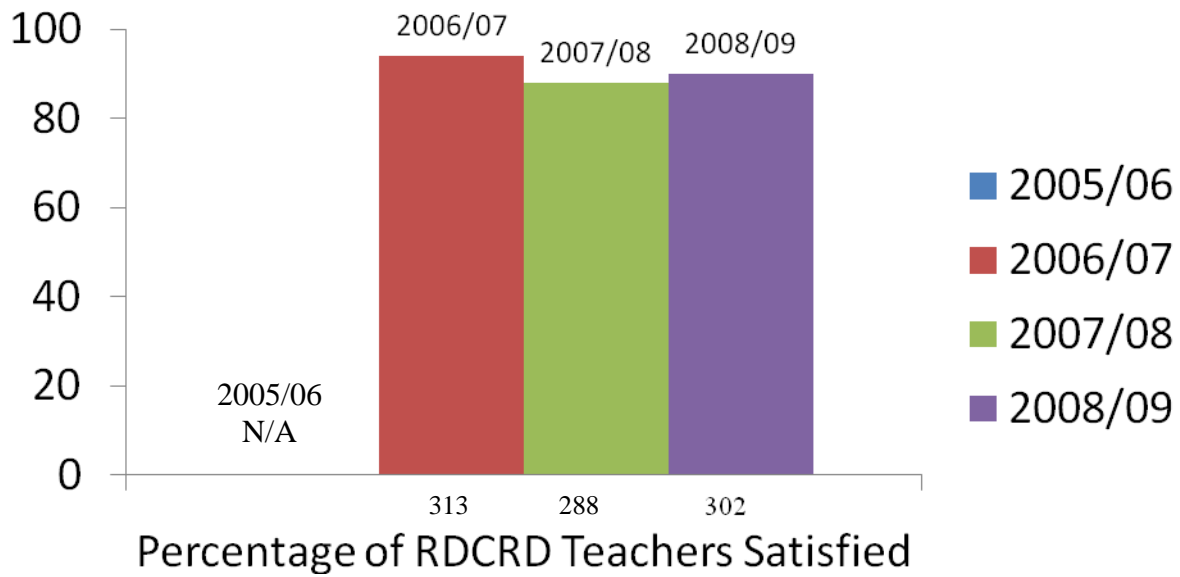
8. With opportunities for input in determining the embedded weekly Professional Development activities in your school?



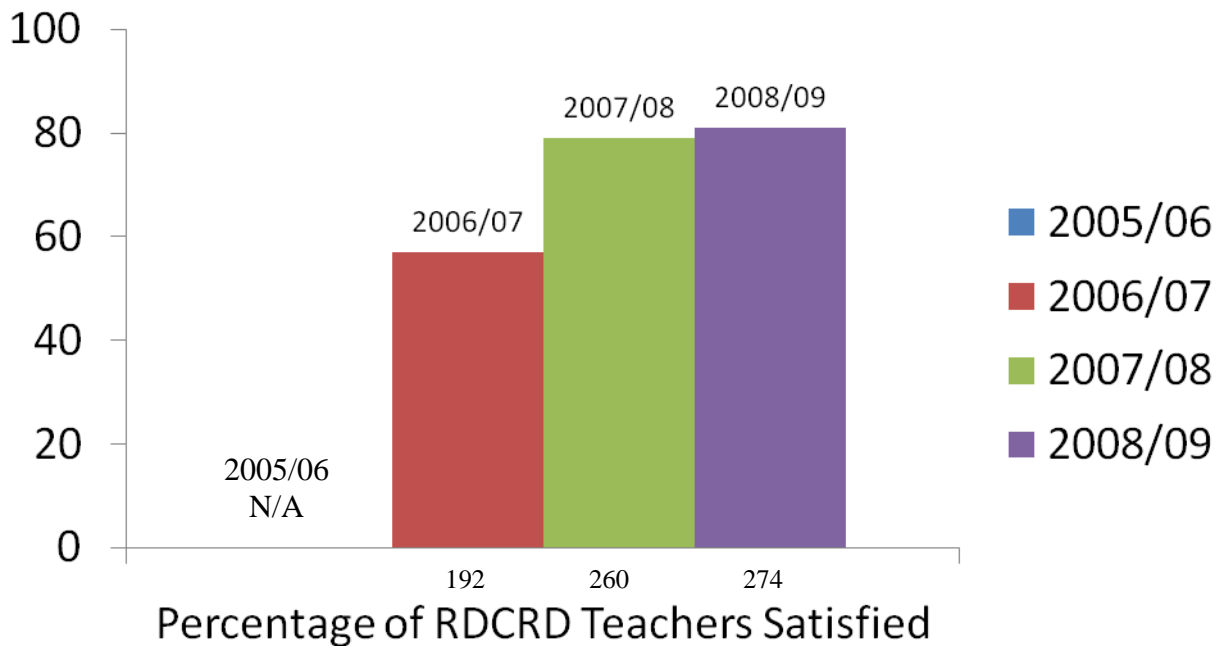
9. With opportunities to share your expertise and skills with other staff as part of school Professional Development activities?



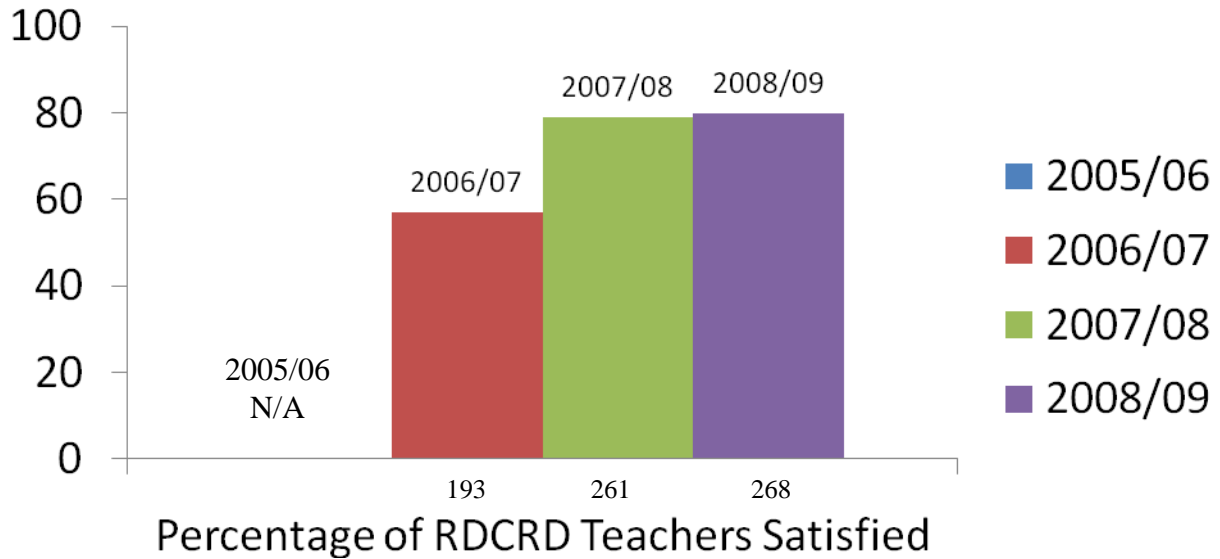
10. With opportunities for division-wide Faith Professional Development Events (August & November)?
